HIGH HOLY DAY TICKETS

In order to ensure the safety and security of everyone who comes to Mishkan Israel, we do use tickets for the High Holy Days so we can account for anyone on the premises. Should you have forgotten your ticket or they are "left in the car," we will ask you to sign in or otherwise verify your identity. Please know that we do this only to be sure you and your loved ones will be safe in the comfort of our sanctuary and in the knowledge that it is only to this end that we are focusing on this effort.

High Holy Day tickets will begin to be mailed mid - August to congregants who have paid at least one quarter of their annual dues. If you need to make payment arrangements or would like to pick up your tickets in person, please contact Merav by Monday, August 6 at (203) 288-3877.

Guest tickets are needed for adult children age 25 and older as well as other family members and guests.
